A sports media camp for high school students

The Carolina Sports Journalism Camp is now accepting applications. Rising high school juniors and seniors with an interest in sports and media are encouraged to apply.

This three-day residential workshop will include instructional sessions in sports broadcasting, sports writing, sports videography and much, much more. Students will be housed on UNC-Chapel Hill's campus.

The Carolina Sports Journalism Camp will include classroom study and practice in the field and will feature visiting sports reporters and sports personalities. Students will take a behind-the-scenes tour of UNC's sports media facilities. They will cover a press conference and experience what it's like to work on a sports media deadline.

Lead instructor Tim Crothers is a former

senior writer for Sports Illustrated and author of three books: The Man Watching, co-author with Roy Williams on Williams' autobiography, Hard Work: A Life On and Off the Court, and The Queen of Katwe, which has been made into a Disney feature film. His work has also appeared in New York Times Magazine and ESPN The Magazine.

Priority deadline is April 1. Final deadline is May 1, should space remain available. Students accepted to the camp with be notified on May 15.

Registration fees of \$600 for in-state students and \$1500 for out-of-state students covers lodging, meals and instruction, plus the camp T-shirt and water bottle.
